Dear Joyce,

As an organization fighting for the stray – and shelter dogs in Turkey, we are very interested in the development of chemical neutering. Our foundations aim is to neuter as many stray dogs and dogs in shelters as possible as this is the only structural and humane solution for the stray dog problem.

We are aware scientists have been working for some time on options to sterilize cats and dogs with non-surgical methods. In our opinion the research should be focussed on the spaying of bitches, since they are the “producers” of the offspring. We also know that so far the non-surgical sterilant GonaCon is very promising, but we’ll always be committed to the catching of all dogs which remains a problem.

The Stichting ActieZwerfhonden (StraydogsCampaign Foundation) supports the Alliance for Contraception in Cats and Dogs (ACC&D), which has been formed to expedite the successful introduction of methods to non-surgically sterilize dogs and cats. ACC&D believes scientists are on track to finding solutions that will help cats and dogs everywhere.

Through this letter we intend to demonstrate our support for ACC&D. By working with ACC&D we are joining the many others who feel that we need new tools to see significant advances in dog and cat welfare.
